We are excited you will be joining us in the House Chamber as a guest page. I hope the following information will answer any questions you may have about our guest page program.

- 1) **Session Days:** Session schedule is up to the discretion of the Speaker of the House and is often unknown until only days before. Please be aware floor session dates and start times can change on short notice. We will be in contact with you to let you know the session schedule as your guest page experience approaches and do our best to reschedule if needed. Please be aware subjects debated in the House Chamber may not always be appropriate for younger guests.
- 2) **Time of Arrival:** House floor sessions typically begin at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. As the session progresses the House may meet on additional days. We ask that all guest pages arrive no later than 30 minutes before session begins so we may get them outfitted and up to speed with our chamber procedures. In the event the time differs, our office will contact you to provide you with the details.
- 3) **What to Wear:** We ask that guest pages arrive wearing a white dress shirt, and black dress pants or skirt; a black blazer and tie or scarf will be provided by our office. If you do not have the aforementioned clothing, we simply ask that you dress as professionally as possible. Blue jeans are not permitted on the House floor.
- 4) **Floor Introduction Bio:** As a guest page, you will have the honor of being introduced by your district Representative during the day's session. We ask that you draft a very brief write up that includes a few sentences on the following information: age, home community, school, hobbies, career aspirations, other goals, and any other related information you may want to share. We will provide your district Representative with the information on the day of the session, so we ask that you arrive with a typed, printed copy of the information (preferably in large type). If you do not have access to a printer the information may be sent to the email listed below.
- 5) **Following the End of Session:** We ask that guest pages arrange to be picked up by a parent or guardian after the conclusion of the day's floor session.

I hope this information has adequately addressed any questions you may have and has excited you about the experience you will enjoy as a guest page in the Alaska House of Representatives. Please don't hesitate to contact us with any remaining questions you may have, and we will be in touch to provide you with any other information you may need as your experience draws near.
